


Sierra Foothill Conservancy an important community asset



SFC has protected over 30,000 acres of natural lands by purchasing properties for nature preserves, partnering with land owners to help them protect their lands through conservation easements, and working with public agencies. We own 8 preserves totaling over 6,000 acres and have worked with local land owners and agencies to protect over 19,000 acres of ranchlands and working forests. SFC was awarded accreditation in 2014, for meeting national standards for excellence, upholding the public trust and ensuring that conservation efforts are permanent.
